

SCHOOL BUILDING ADMINISTRATION

The Sunapee School Board reaffirms the rights and responsibilities of the building principals for the administration of their various programs and buildings within the broad scope of the adopted board policies.

Specifically, the principal of the individual school is the responsible head and the professional leader in the development of the educational program and the improvement of instruction in the school of which he or she is the principal and in interpreting that school to the community.

All building principals shall be responsible for the school buildings and grounds to which they are assigned. They shall be responsible for and shall have authority over the actions of students, professionals, non-professional employees, visitors, volunteers and persons hired to perform special tasks.

All principals shall keep the Superintendent and /or his/her designee informed of activities in their building.

A principal shall attend board meetings as requested by the Superintendent or his/her designee or the board.

They shall perform the powers and duties of principals prescribed by the State Board of Education regulations.
