

BOMB THREATS

In the event of a call or notice to the effect that a bomb has been placed in a school or any other building or establishment, the following procedures are recommended:

1. Building shall be evacuated.
2. Local police shall be notified.
3. Building teams shall make a routine inspection of the building. Principals shall set up teams to conduct searches in separate parts of the building. These teams shall become familiar with the area that they will be searching.
4. A representative from the police or fire department will be asked to assist each building team with the search.
5. After the routine search has been made and nothing has been found, the principal can recall the students into the building.

Any decision concerning the dismissal of school pupils and subsequent action after the above procedures have been followed is the prerogative of the Superintendent after receiving recommendations from the building principal(s).

Persons calling in "Bomb Scares" and/or false alarms will be subject to conviction by the courts and suspension from school pending School Board Action.
