

UNAUTHORIZED EMPLOYEE ABSENCES

Any strike, job action or withholding of services by a public employee is illegal.

Any employee of the Board who engages in a strike or job action, or who withholds services, absents himself or herself without leave or authorization, or declines to perform all of his/her duties and responsibilities will be acting contrary to the law of the state, to the Board policies and to any applicable individual contract.

Any employee who so acts will:

1. Suffer a deduction of salary for every day s/he is absent from work.
2. Have an official reprimand placed in his/her permanent record.
3. Be subject to immediate discharge or other appropriate disciplinary action.
