The School Board believes that student activities at school are a vital part of the total educational program and should be used as a means for developing positive attitudes and skills. The Board believes that school citizenship, as reflected in student activities, is a measure of the achievement of important school goals. The Board recognizes that the greatest values to be derived from both curricular and co-curricular student activities occur when such activities are developed and encouraged through participation among, or the knowledge of, the student body, interested members in the community and school staff.

All student activity funds should be used for the purpose for which they were raised. The management of these funds shall be supervised by the school administration.
