

INTERDISCIPLINARY CREDIT POLICY

Credits for course work earned in one content area may be used toward meeting any graduation requirements in another content area through the awarding of interdisciplinary credit. Any graduation requirement in a subject area may be earned through interdisciplinary credit, subject to the following conditions:

- 1) Graduation requirements met by interdisciplinary credit shall be clearly designated on student transcripts;
- 2) Interdisciplinary credit shall be counted only once in meeting graduation requirements; and
- 3) The high school principal may approve a particular course for interdisciplinary credit if he/she determines that:
 - a. The course has been adopted by a faculty team and
 - b. The course addressed the objectives for the subject area in which the credit is to be counted.
