

EVALUATION OF INSTRUCTIONAL PROGRAMS

It shall be the responsibility of the Superintendent to report periodically to the School Board on the progress the district is making towards the attainment of its educational goals.

Instructional programs shall be directed by the Superintendent in cooperation with the school principals.

The purposes of evaluation of instruction will be:

- To show the relationship between achievement and the district's stated goals
- To identify instructional strengths and weaknesses
- To determine educational needs and provide information for planning for improvement
- To assess the suitability of programs in terms of community requirements
- To provide data for public information

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
