

STUDENT ADMISSIONS

ADMISSION OF POST-SECONDARY STUDENTS

Individuals who reside within the district, who have graduated from the Sunapee Middle High School or any accredited high school or who have received credit for completing high school, may be admitted by the Superintendent of Schools to post-graduate study, either as a full-time or part-time student during regular school hours. The candidate may be admitted with the recommendation of the principal and in accordance with the terms set forth below:

- a. The acceptance of the candidate must not present a staffing nor a space problem which would lessen the effectiveness of instruction to regular students.
- b. The candidate must present and have approved a clearly defined and reasonable educational program.
- c. The candidate may be required to pay for books, lab fees and equipment as appropriate.
- d. The candidate will abide by all rules and regulations set forth in the Student Handbook. Failure to abide by all rules and regulations set forth in the Student Handbook shall result in immediate termination of the candidate's attendance at the school.
- e. The candidate must provide evidence of up to date immunization in accordance with state law.
- f. The candidate will demonstrate his prior commitment to education.
- g. The candidate's previous behavior record in school is satisfactory.
- h. The Superintendent determines that admission of the candidate will be consistent with the best interest of the school and its students.
- i. The Superintendent's decision is final and may not be appealed.
