

ADMISSION OF FOREIGN EXCHANGE STUDENTS

The Sunapee School District welcomes students from other countries to its schools under these conditions:

1. A resident of the school district and/or tuition student who has been interviewed by the principal or a member of the guidance staff must agree to house the student and act as that student's host during the school year.
2. The student must be enrolled in a bona fide foreign student exchange program.
3. The student must be proficient in the English language.
4. All federal immigration forms must be completed in advance of the student's arrival.

When the above conditions are in place, the principal of the school in which the student wants to enroll will send his or her recommendation for admission to the Superintendent of Schools for School Board approval.

Foreign exchange students will be considered students of the Sunapee School District in every respect except that they will not be included in class ranking and/or receive a diploma.
