

ADMISSION OF RESIDENT STUDENTS

The school district of residence of a student is defined by RSA 193:12, II.

New Resident Students

All new resident students, accompanied by a parent/guardian, should register at school before opening day and as early as possible.

Children entering school for the first time must have proof of physical examination, immunization records, a copy of the child's birth certificate and proof of residency satisfactory to the Superintendent or his/her designee. Principals or their designees will meet with new children and parents to explain school programs.

It is understood that the central office administration reserves the right to grant special permission for attendance at schools other than those considered to be the home school of the student. Special permission may be granted for reasons including, but not limited to; special education students, hardship cases (child care arrangements are not considered hardship cases), or other extenuating circumstances as determined by the administrator. The administration further reserves the right to limit special exceptions based on class size and overall school enrollment.

Parents must provide the following as proof of residence:
