

STUDENT CONDUCT

Student behavior shall be based on respect and consideration for the rights of others.

Annually, at the opening of school each year, students shall receive a handbook which has been approved by the School Board. Students and parents have a responsibility to be familiar with the rules and regulations of the school.

Student conduct that causes material or substantial disruption to the school environment, interferes with the rights of others, presents a threat to the health and safety of students, employees, and visitors, violates other board Policies or is otherwise inappropriate is prohibited. Students are expected to maintain appropriate classroom behavior that allows teachers and staff to perform their professional duties effectively and without disruption.

Students will conduct themselves in a manner fitting to their age level and maturity and with respect and consideration for the rights of others while on school district property or on property within the jurisdiction of the school district, while on school owned and/or operated school or chartered vehicles and/or while attending or engaged in school activities. Students may also be disciplined for off-campus behavior in accordance with the provisions of Policies JICD.
