

UNAUTHORIZED COMMUNICATION DEVICES

Unauthorized student use of cell phones, camera phones, pagers, beepers, and other similar electronic communication devices is strictly prohibited during the school day. This includes lunch periods and passing periods, as well as on school sponsored trips and driver education classes. Such devices are to be kept in a student's assigned locker with the power turned off. The Board recommends that these devices not be brought to school.

Additionally, it is prohibited for students to take, store, disseminate, transfer, view, or share obscene, pornographic, lewd, or otherwise illegal/inappropriate images or photographs, whether by electronic data transfer or other means, including but not limited to texting and e-mailing. Any student found to have engaged in such conduct may be reported to local law enforcement authorities and may face criminal penalties in accordance with applicable law. School administrators may refer such matters to local law enforcement if the administrator believes student action in this regard involves illegal activity (e.g., pornography.)

The school district will not be responsible for loss, damage or theft of any electronic communication device brought to the school.
