

STUDENT FUND-RAISING ACTIVITIES

The Board recognizes that students may wish to engage in fund-raising activities. All such fund-raising activities require prior approval of the Superintendent or his/her designee. No solicitation of funds for organized drives shall occur without written permission of the Principal. Raffles of student-made or donated items may be held for the benefit of school programs, as deemed appropriate and with prior written approval of the Principal. Activities that are prohibited include, but are not limited to, the following:

- 50/50 Raffles
- Casino Nights
- Games of Chance
- NCAA Basketball Pool
- Poker Nights
- World Series Pool

There is to be no sale of candy or carbonated beverages to students within the schools during regular school hours without written permission of the Principal.

Fund-raising shall not be school-sponsored unless it is approved by the Superintendent and/or his/her designee. All fund-raising money must be deposited in the school activity accounts which shall be maintained according to standards and procedures established by the Superintendent or his/her designee, and these accounts shall be audited annually.
