

INVOLVEMENT IN DECISION MAKING

Community:

The School Board recognizes that the public has vast resources of training and experience useful to schools. The strength of the local school district is in large measure determined by the degree to which these resources are involved in supporting the improvement of the local educational program.

Staff:

The Superintendent will attempt to evolve with professional and non-professional employees channels for the ready inter-communication of ideas and feelings regarding the operation of the schools. He/she should weigh with care the counsel given by employees especially that given by groups designated to represent large segments of the staff, and shall inform the Board of all such counsel in presenting reports of administrative action and in presenting recommendations for Board action.

Students:

A primary task of the school is to create a stimulating learning climate. This climate is created when students work together with school staff in such activities as planning and evaluating school programs.
