Article 3. Shall the District raise and appropriate as an operating budget, not including appropriations by special warrant articles and other appropriations voted separately, the amounts set forth on the budget posted with the warrant, or as amended by vote of the first session, for the purposes set forth therein, totaling Eleven Million, Seven Hundred Twenty Three Thousand, Six Hundred and Forty Two Dollars (11,723,642)? Should this article be defeated, the default budget shall be Eleven Million, Six Hundred Thirty Thousand, Six Hundred Eleven Dollars (11,630,611), which is the same as last year, with certain adjustments required by previous action of the District or by law; or the governing body may hold one special meeting, in accordance with RSA 40:13, X and XVI, to take up the issue of a revised operating budget only.

Article 4. Shall the District approve the cost items included in the collective bargaining agreement reached between the Sunapee School Board and the Sunapee Teachers Association, which calls for the following increases and benefits totaling:
