

Indirect Object Pronouns

- An indirect object is: an object that indirectly receives the action of the verb.
 - > Ej: I give money to Jorge. - I.O. To whom?
- An Indirect Object Pronoun (IOP) is: a pronoun that replaces or supplements the I.O.
 - > Ej: I give money to him. She bakes cookies for me. - I.O. For whom?
- There are 6 IOPS in Spanish:

- The IOP can go:
 - me - me
 - you - te
 - him/ her/it/ - le
 - NOS - us
 - OS - you guys
 - les - them, you all
- Attached to end of infinitive
- Attached to end of affirm. command
- before conjugated verb
- Attached to end of pres. participle

Ejemplos:

I give money to him. le

Yo le doy dinero.

Yo le doy dinero a él.

She bakes cookies for me. - me

Ella hornea galletas (para mí.)

We are going to buy books for the children. D.O. I.O. -les

(Les) Vamos a comprarles libros.

Felipe is singing to you. I.O. -te

Felipe (te) está cantandote.
