

Los Verbos Reflexivos

- Reflexive verbs are used to show action that **one does to one's self**
 - > Ej: **I wash my hands.** **Felipe brushes his teeth.**
- Every reflexive verb must have a **reflexive pronoun** that agrees with it.
 - > They are:

me	nos	Me lavo <u>las</u> manos.
te	os	
se	se	
- Whatever form the verb is conjugated in is the form the reflexive pronoun must be.
 - > Ej: **Felipe se cepilla los dientes.**
 - Definite articles w/ parts of the body
- Reflexive pronouns are placed:
 - > Directly **before** the conjugated verb. **I wash my hands.**
 - « Ej: **Me lavo las manos.**
 - Not all verbs are reflexive
 - > Attached to the end of the **Infinitive**
 - « Ej: **Voy a lavarme las manos.**
 - Reflexive verbs can be used non-reflexively
 - > Attached to the end of a **present participle**
 - « Ej: **Estoy lavándome las manos.**
 - I wash the dishes.
 - > Attached to the end of an **affirmative command**
 - « Ej: **Lávate las manos.**
 - ando
 - iendo
 - * No reflexive pronoun

The boys are going to go to bed.
 Los chicos ^{se} van a acostarse.

Julia is putting on makeup.
 J. ^{se} está poniéndose el maquillaje.
 J. ^{se} está maquillándose.
